



Firestone Destination LE4 – Frequently Asked Questions

1. What vehicles are Destination LE4 designed for?

The Destination LE4 is designed for CUVs, SUVs and light trucks and is available in 65 sizes covering 15- to 22-inch rim diameters (See Annex A). Within a single product line, the LE4 provides extensive vehicle coverage that surpasses that of many competitor highway tires, with popular fitments including Ford F-150, Ram 1500, Chevrolet Trailblazer, Mazda CX-5 and Nissan Armada. It is designed to deliver long-lasting wear, confident wet-weather performance and year-round capability for daily commuting, family travel, road trips and hauling cargo.

2. How does the Destination LE4 compare to the older Destination LE3 tire?

The Destination LE4 takes everything drivers loved about the LE3, like its comfortable, quiet ride and dependable comfort, and upgrades it:

- **Shorter Stopping Distances:** In internal testing, the LE4 demonstrated a 2.6% reduction in dry stopping distance, stopping 2 feet shorter than the LE3¹.
- **Longer Wear Life:** Projected to wear 16% longer than the Firestone Destination LE3 tire².
- **Sharper Wet Handling:** Thinner 3D sipes throughout the tread pattern help improve grip and control on rainy roads.

Ultimately, it delivers longer wear, sharper handling and greater year-round confidence than the LE3, all at an everyday value.

3. How does the Destination LE4 handle rain and light snow?

The Destination LE4 was built for everyday driving in changing weather conditions. It features thinner 3D sipes across the tread pattern that help improve grip and shorten stopping distances in wet weather and light snow. While it offers dependable traction for daily driving across changing seasons, it is an all-season highway tire, not a dedicated winter tire. If you regularly drive in areas with harsh winters or frequent heavy snowfall, dedicated winter tires are still the best choice.

4. What helps the Destination LE4 last longer?

The Destination LE4 includes a deeper tread depth, an advanced compound and a non-directional tread pattern that helps reduce irregular wear and offer an extended tread life. The Destination LE4 is backed by a 70,000-mile limited mileage warranty³.

5. Does the Destination LE4 come with a warranty?

Yes. The Destination LE4 tires are backed by a 70,000-mile limited mileage warranty. Additionally, Firestone offers a 90-Day Buy & Try Guarantee. If you're not satisfied

within the first 90 days, you can exchange them for another set of Firestone or Bridgestone tires. Conditions apply, and details are available at [FirestoneTire.com/warranty](https://www.firestone.com/warranty).

6. How does the Destination LE4 perform compared to its competitors?

In internal testing, the Destination LE4 demonstrated better stopping performance over key competitors at 55 mph:

- **Toyto Open Country H/T II:** Stops 8 feet shorter in dry conditions (7.7% reduction) and 8 feet shorter in wet conditions (6.9% reduction)⁴.
- **BFGoodrich Advantage Control HT:** Stops 2 feet shorter in dry conditions (2.1% reduction) and 4 feet shorter in wet conditions (4.0% reduction)⁵.

In external testing the Destination LE4 showed that it can go longer before replacement:

- Projected to wear **43% longer** than the BFGoodrich Advantage Control HT tire².
- Projected to wear **9% longer** than the General Grabber H/T tire².

7. Can a tire with deeper tread depth still deliver good fuel efficiency?

Yes. Historically, deeper tread depth can add rolling resistance, but the Destination LE4 overcomes this through advanced material design. By integrating light, high-strength structural cords, the LE4 is able to maintain low rolling resistance. This allows drivers to get the benefits of longer tread life without compromising overall fuel efficiency.

8. Does the Destination LE4 support sustainability or help drivers save long-term?

Absolutely. Because the Destination LE4 is designed for longer tread life, drivers may not need to replace their tires as often. Fewer tire replacements over time means using fewer materials and generating less overall waste, making it a long-lasting, practical choice for your vehicle and your wallet.

9. What manufacturing advancements were used in developing the Destination LE4?

Developed at the Bridgestone Americas Technology Center in Akron, Ohio, the Destination LE4 marks two significant technical milestones for Firestone:

- **High-Strength, Lightweight Carcass Architecture:** Structural plies and steel cords that preserve efficiency while extending wear.
- **Advanced Compound Mixing:** A mixing process that creates greater ingredient consistency throughout the rubber, enhancing molecular structure for improved wear, grip and precise handling.

10. Who is the Destination LE4 best suited for?

If you drive a CUV, SUV or light truck and want a tire that can handle daily driving, road trips and changing weather throughout the year, the Destination LE4 was designed

with you in mind. It combines long tread life, dependable all-season performance and a comfortable ride, making it a strong choice for drivers who spend most of their time on paved roads.
